### Description

Together for an United Europe! The aim of the project was that the participant countries should think about those measures that should be taken in order to create a stable and secure future for their settlements considering the direction Europe heads in. They should develop local values and identify some guidelines that in the long run contribute to achieve this goal. The project helps us achieve this goal and helps our partners know each other better and create some long-term and varied relationships. 7 countries participate in this project, and they are very different, due to this fact they have to learn much from each another, they can exchange experiences and good ideas. The project event was held in Comuna Lazarea, implying conference, presentations, round-table discussions, debates, study visits and cultural programmes. Due to this project the partners can get to know one another and their cultures better and thanks to the cultural events they can experience Europe's diversity and multiculturalism. At the same time the project emphasizes the importance of an active participation. The identification of the local development possibilities is very important regarding the development of the settlements. The transnational dimension of the project will be ensured by disseminating the project results across borders, through the cooperation of several partner organizations from different participating countries. The activities address euroskepticism as a problem and highlight solidarity in time of crisis, after Brexit, give reflections to the current immigration issue and celebrate a common, united future of Europe. Further, our project aims to raise awareness of European remembrance, common history and promotion of mutual understanding in Eu. At the end we made a booklet and a DVD that will include description of the problems addressed by the project, the solutions identified by participants, activities and methods used during the project.

Our other goal is, of course, to take advantage of this opportunity to draw the attention of the press and citizens to all the positive things that the European Union has provided for our peoples, and in addition to that, in particular, to emphasize the concerns of the civil society and its organizations in our countries. We would like to point out not only the measures to be taken, but also the role that participatory democracy must play in order for citizens to regain their trust in the Union and in the national and European institutions that serve them. During the meeting, we examined three aspects as a whole: the social and economic dimensions, as well as immigration and integration policies. The European project is in real danger. The survival of the Union is at stake, especially due to the effects of nationalist and

populist forces, even though not so long ago no one in the member states questioned its usefulness, and practically everyone who was not yet a member wanted to join it. Europe was a safe, peaceful haven characterized by democracy, progress and prosperity for both citizens and businesses. We still remember the horrors of nationalism and xenophobia, the damage borders and walls have caused to freedom and the economy. For the sake of the future, it is also necessary to define and justify the measures that are absolutely necessary now, and also the spirit in which they should be developed. In order to regain the trust of the citizens, we must give Europe a real social dimension and prevent all kinds of social regression and the growth of inequality.

A Facebook page was created, where the most important information was included about the event, pictures, videos. We put a lot of emphasis on social media, as this channel is the best way to reach young people.

During the event, reports will continuously appear on the event's social media page. After the end of the project, a small summary booklet with pictures of the program and events was prepared, which the partner countries will also receive from the village mayor's office. This booklet will also contain a brief description of the program. We will also send the finished booklet to the media. The activities were also promoted with the help of the Facebook page, and at the same time, this provides a contact interface for partners and other interested parties even after the end of the project. The summary booklet prepared at the end of the project was sent to those who were unable to participate in the event, informing them of what was said and the conclusions drawn, and at the same time it was sent to the partner settlements so that they too can promote the CERV program.

With the help of pliants and press news the entire region was informed about the events of the project, thereby better promoting the goals of the project.

The cultural and gastronomic events organized in the framework of the project draw the attention of those who would otherwise not get involved to the project, so they could get to know the CERV program. As a result of the project, the partner towns can build a long-term and multifaceted partnership relationship. The cooperation contract signed by the participating settlements will state that everyone will try to apply the results of the project in their own settlement, promote it and report the consequences and lessons learned to the partners from time to time.

Within the event this most important concrete result was achieved:

- Mutual motivation - Presentation of the activities of each organization, which is closely related to specific topics,
  - Lecture involving the citizens of partner communities about active European citizenship, active civic participation in local democracy
  - Film screening and discussion about mutual motivation in terms of future cooperation,
  - Intellectual competition between teams of villages,
  - Workshop
  - Presentation of partner organizations,
  - Productions of amateur art groups, folk groups and soloists from invited delegations,
- The points listed in the program will bring tangible results in many ways:
- New relationships are formed between local governments, NGOs, entrepreneurs, and especially between citizens and families.
  - Sport and intellectual competition, cultural programs will encourage especially the young generation to develop relationships.
  - Recognize the possibilities in EU for benefit to the communities and regions in the future.
  - Professional experience from interactive communication and workshop, using this experience will help the professional development of

each partners.

This event is a big, international, but regional program too, so it will have positive influence to the citizens, activates them to the common activity, they consider the possibilities of cooperation with create a non-profit organizations, forming alliances, engaging in cross-border programs. Citizens of EU countries will accept european ideas and cooperation during the events, wich would have direct impact to the populatiry of EU, and faster accepting of EU policy.
